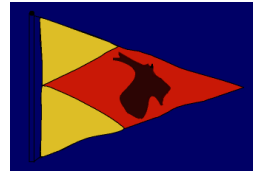




# SKERRIES REGATTA

### 1. Details

The 2020 Skerries Regatta will be held in Skerries Sailing Club on **Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> & Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2020**. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* except where stated in this notice or the sailing instructions which will be available upon registration.

### 2. Time of Registration

All registrations will take place in **The Race Office, Skerries Sailing Club 9.00 AM to 11.30 AM Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> August**. Entries accepted at the sole discretion of the Race Committee. Forms are available on [www.skerriessailingclub.com](http://www.skerriessailingclub.com)

### 3. Schedule of Races for Dinghy Classes

Sat 22 <sup>nd</sup> August	Race 1	Warning Signal @ 13:00hrs
	Race 2	As Soon as possible after Race 1
Sun 23 <sup>rd</sup> August	Race 3	Warning Signal @ 12:00hrs
	Race 4	As soon as possible after previous race
	Race 5	As soon as possible after previous race

No warning signal will be given later than 16:00 on Sunday.

Individual starts may be given for classes of more than 5 boats. Classes of less than five boats, or any class, may be started with other classes, at the discretion of the Race Officer.

There is a one day GP14 competition on Sunday that will be on the same course as regatta, GP14 class will have their own start and will be the first starting dinghy class.

## 4. Entry Fee

For SSC members who have paid 2020 membership or are paying via monthly instalments, Entry is free for the 2020 regatta.

For non-SSC members wishing to compete in the regatta the entry fee is €25.  
For GP14 sailors sailing the one day event on the Sunday the entry fee is €20.

## 6. Courses to be sailed

The courses sailed shall be identified to sailors in the Sailing Instructions.

## 7. Scoring System

### 7.1 Dinghy Races

For Dinghies, five Races are scheduled of which two shall be completed to constitute a championship. The Low-Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A will apply; except that if less than four races are sailed all shall be counted. If 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her races excluding her worst score.

### 7.2 Cruiser Races

## 8. Handicaps.

Cruisers shall supply their ECHO handicaps on entry or will be assigned a handicap by the Race Committee. Boats which are racing members of SSC shall use their designated original ECHO handicap.

## 9. Membership:

All entrants shall be given temporary membership of Skerries Sailing Club from midnight on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> August until midnight on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> August and free boat parking or mooring, where available, for the same duration.

## 10. Prizes.

### 10.1 - Cruiser Prizes

Cruiser Regatta prizes will be awarded at the main prize giving ceremony on Sunday afternoon.

### 10.2 - Dinghy Prizes

Dinghy prizes will be awarded according to class turnout, following racing on Sunday afternoon.
