Additional information

For this event we need to keep everyone safe from the potential effects of Covid 19. There is a huge amount that each of you already knows about minimizing the risks. Nonetheless, we need to ask that everyone adhere to the following guidelines.

Firstly;

On arrival you will fill in the Covid 19 Health Check form for participants, Only registered participants may visit the club at any time during the regatta. Participants are required to maintain a 2 meter social distance at all times where possible.

Please wear a facemask wherever social distancing is not possible

Wear a facemask at registration.

Any person who is feeling unwell and is displaying the symptoms of Covid 19 or has reason to believe that they have been exposed to Covid 19, must withdraw from the event and advise accordingly.

Briefings will take place outside to facilitate social distancing.

The clubhouse will not be in general use.

Changing rooms will not be in use.

There will be access to toilets.

There is a huge amount of acreage at our club, there will be ample space to safely camp, park, store boats, trailers and caravans.

Please follow directions on arrival.

There will be no catering and no evening social event

To avoid congregating on the slipway, when rigged, park your boat down on the beach ready to launch. A social distance of two meters must be maintained.

Lots of caveats, but the idea is for everyone to stay safe, and enjoy some good racing.
