



The following assumptions are made:
 The current changes direction one hour before high tide Skerries.
 High Tide Skerries is 15 minutes before High Tide Dublin.
 Positioning of a race on the spreadsheet is for the start only and is approximate. You must extrapolate the tidal impact for the remainder of the race.

Time progresses down the chart. Each coloured line represents one hour.
 A rising tide uses the convention of time increasing from 1 hour after low water to 6, a falling tide convention is to time it from 6 hours before low water to 1.

None of the material in this chart is binding on the Race Committee which may alter race times and thus make the chart irrelevant.

Races 4a and 5a are optional and might not be run.

Numbers given to races are sequential and might not represent actual race numbers. Check the dates.

Relative strength of current is indicated by a green, orange or red colour as in the legend below. Numbers represent time after or before the current changes direction.
