NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of Irish Sailing will apply.
- 1.3 The rules of the GP14 Class Association will apply

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the GP14 class.
- **2.1** All boats shall have a valid Class Certificate of registration and measurement issued prior to the commencement of this event.
- 2.2 Each helm must be a paid-up GP14 Class International Association member.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form together with the required fee.
- **2.4** Registration and entry fee payment should be made online at the Killaloe Sailing Club event webpage (https://www.killaloesailingclub.com/gp14munsters/)

Adults: €60 Youth: €40

(A GP14 association capitation fee of €5 per entrant is included in this fee.)

3 SCHEDULE

3.1 6 Races are scheduled:

Saturday, April 20th – up to 4 races Sunday, April 21st – up to 4 races

3.2 The scheduled time of the first warning signals will be:

Saturday, April 20th, 12:00 hrs Sunday, April 21st, 11:00 hrs

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available online on the event webpage https://www.killaloesailingclub.com/gp14munsters/ and at the event on Saturday morning.

5 SCORING & PRIZES

- **5.1** Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- **5.2** When fewer than four (4) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- **5.3** When four (4) or more races have been completed, a boats' series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- **5.4** When eight (8) or more races have been completed, a boats' series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.
 - Prizes will be given as follows: 1st, 2nd and 3rd Gold Fleet 1st, 2nd and 3rd Silver Fleet 1st, 2nd
 and 3rd Bronze Fleet

Association Trophies shall be held by the winners and returned by them (in good time and in good order) to the Organisers of the event in the following year. The winners shall be responsible for engraving the trophies. Any GP14 Association Trophies presented shall not be removed from Ireland.

6 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

• Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage, and/or personal injury, and/or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

7 INSURANCE

• Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €3,000,000 or the equivalent.

9 CATERING

- Competitors are responsible for providing their own food and drink.
- A dinner in the clubhouse has been arranged for 18:30 hrs on Saturday, April 20th at a cost of €20 per person. (Main course, desert tea/coffee)

- Refreshments will be provided to all competitors on Sunday, April 21st
- Coffee and snacks will be made available onshore throughout Saturday and Sunday
